Awards will be made to candidates who demonstrate outstanding performance or potential in at least one of our major team games:

Boys' Sports	Girls' Sports
Rugby Football	Netball
Hockey	Hockey
Cricket	Cricket
Tennis	Tennis

Applications must identify at least two referees for Rugby School to contact.

A report will also be requested from the Head of the candidate's current school to establish that the boys and girls selected will also flourish academically at Rugby.

Candidates will be required to come to Rugby School for a day of assessment on **Friday 17 November 2023 (boys) and Friday 24 November 2023 (girls)**. Boys and girls will take part in activities designed to establish their intrinsic motivation to be a sports scholar, athletic ability, decision making under pressure and potential to respond to coaching as well as having the opportunity to demonstrate their particular skills in one or more specific sports.

Candidates do not need to have a place to enter Rugby School before applying for the Sports Scholarship. The availability of a place in the School cannot be guaranteed, however, every effort would be made to find a place for the winner of a Sports Scholarship, subject to entrance tests.

Candidates do not need to play all of the above sports to be considered for a sports scholarship. We will award a scholarship based on excellent performance / potential excellent performance in one sport or very good performance / potential very good performance in two or more sports.

Award and Augmentation

The value of a Scholarship award is a fee concession of 5% which parents or legal guardians of the awardee may elect to accept. More than one Scholarship can be awarded to a candidate although the total fee reduction available is limited to 5%. The level of fee concession provided can be augmented by bursary support up to 100% of the boarding or day fees subject to means assessment. To access bursary support a Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances must be completed and should be submitted to the Bursar before the examination closing date. Completed bursary applications received after the closing date will not be assessed until after the result of a scholarship application is known and any bursary award may not then be offered at the time of joining the School. We are not able to provide an indication of the amount of financial assistance that may be available until the Registration Form has been completed and returned to the Admissions Office, together with payment of the Registration Fee. exceptional awards with a fee concession which may be greater than 5% can be made where, during the assessment process, we identify exceptional potential.
